

Rome has a comprehensive transportation system.

The fare for a single ride on the bus/metro/tram/train(within the city) is 1.50€. Tickets can be purchased from vending machines at Metro stations, at the Tabacchi shops, or via the TicketAppy App or MyCicero App.

For the best routes try the Moovit App, which will calculate the route you need to take, live navigation, and real-time schedules.

Be sure to validate your ticket at the machines at the train station or onboard the bus

### TAXI

Get the FreeNow or itTaxi Apps to order a cab from your phone, call +39 06 3570, or go to Taxi stand. There is a taxi stand exiting the building to the left on the right hand side of the street, near Vero.
